

## Logistics Checklist for Learning Online

Use this checklist to set up your learning environment and required technology.

Create Space for Learning	
	<b>Location.</b> If possible, create a distinct and well-lit space at home not used for other activities like cooking or sleeping. Keep water and healthy snacks nearby.
•	<b>Minimize distractions.</b> Close browser tabs and windows not relevant to your work. Turn off all notifications from emails and social media. Keep the TV off, etc.
•	<b>Take regular breaks from the computer.</b> Take frequent small breaks, but try not to interrupt your flow for too long.
٥	<b>Gather contact and support information.</b> Keep relevant information for your course easily accessible. Collect the phone numbers, email addresses, and support links for your institution.
	<b>Schedule a daily routine.</b> Establish a regular structure to your daily schedule to help you manage your time and keep your studies on track.
	<b>Stay organized.</b> Keep a calendar of tasks and due dates; keep notes handy.
Gather Your Accounts	
	<b>Accounts and Apps.</b> Before it begins, review all the technology and software required for your course.
	<ul> <li>Install any needed software applications (e.g. most video conferencing tools require an application to run).</li> <li>Test the application to troubleshoot any problems.</li> <li>Make sure you have the required account details or login information for any software or services required.</li> <li>Make sure you are able to access cloud services that might be used to upload assignments (e.g. Google Drive, Dropbox, Microsoft One Drive).</li> </ul>
	<b>Hardware.</b> Keep handy all your cables and extra devices like a computer mouse, keyboard, web camera, headset and microphone.
	<b>Internet Connection.</b> If you are able, connect directly to your router with an ethernet cable to minimize reliance on wifi.
	<ul> <li>Have a plan if you lose Internet access or wifi.</li> <li>Download course materials to work on assignments offline if you lose your internet connection.</li> <li>Check if your online course and learning platform will work on mobile (i.e. phone, tablet).</li> </ul>
